1. The present perfect tense is used when:

- 1. Talking about actions or experiences at an unspecified time in the past:
 - Example: *I have visited Japan*. (We don't specify when.)
- 2. Talkimg about past actions or experiences that are connected to the present.

It is formed by using the auxiliary verb "have" (or "has" for the third-person singular) followed by the past participle of the main verb.

Example:

DAMOUR

(I / YOU/ We/ They) have cleaned my room.

(She/He/ It) has finished her homework.

2. Negative Form:

To form the negative form of the present perfect tense, we use the auxiliary verb "have not" (or "has not" for the third-person singular) followed by the past participle of the main verb.

Example:

Long Form	Short form
I have not visited the park.	I haven't visited the park.
He has not eaten his lunch.	He hasn't eaten his lunch.

3. Interrogative Form:

To form the interrogative form of the present perfect tense, we invert the subject and the auxiliary verb "have" (or "has" for the third-person singular). The past participle of the main verb comes after the auxiliary verb.

Example:

Have you read the book?

Has she finished her project?

4. **Time expressions** used with the present perfect.

(already, just, recently, since, for, yet)

Yet: has a negative meaning. /// Example: I haven't finished my project yet.
